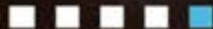




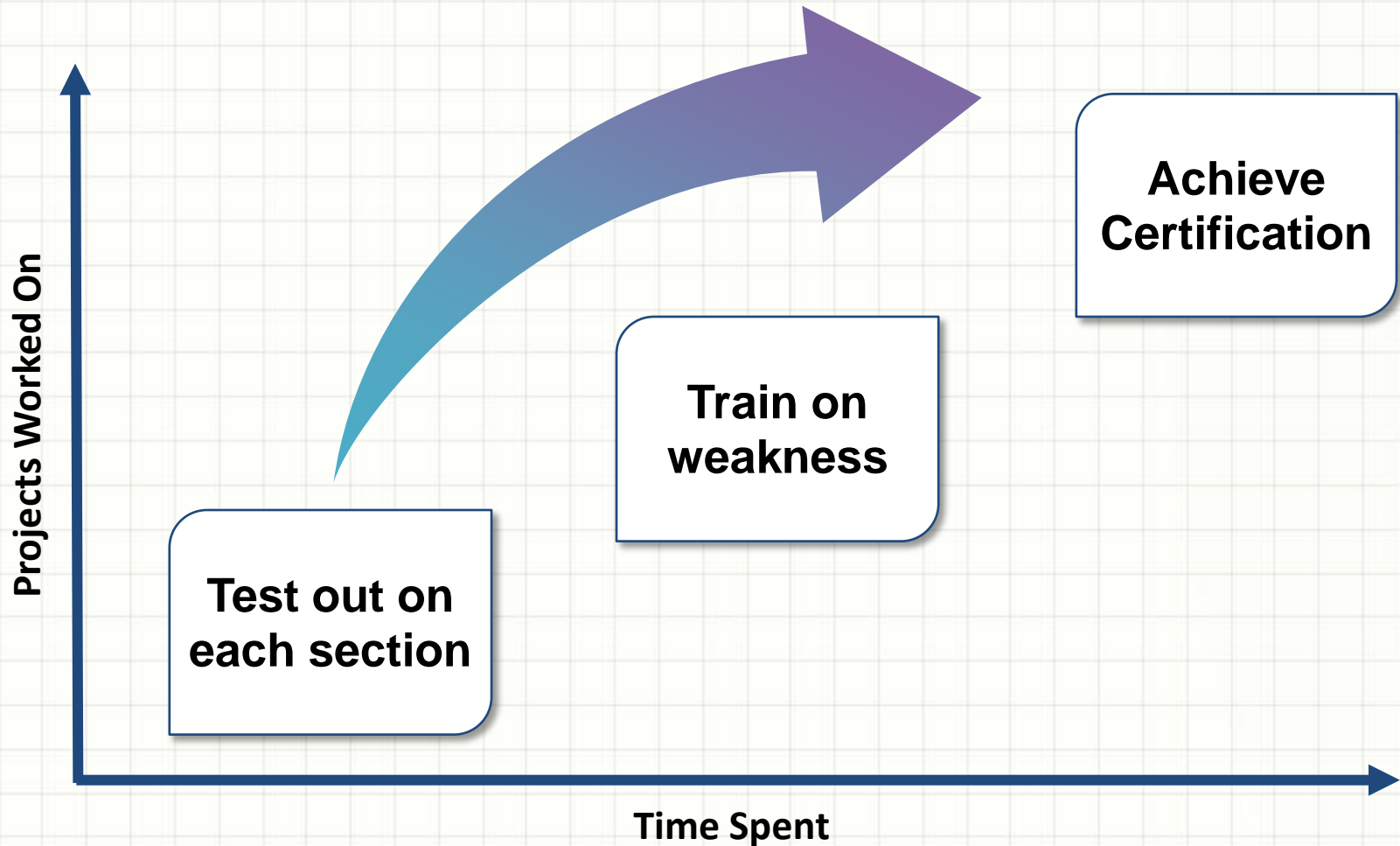
We had 9 working groups that covered all repair sections of the chassis.
